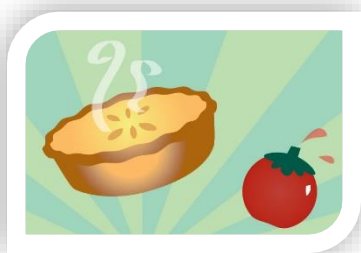

- They can be frozen and reheated later without losing their quality.
- The pies are pre-baked, chilled and individually wrapped.
- The pies have an egg wash on top, are not gluten free and may contain traces of nuts and sesame seeds.
